REGULATIONS

- NO HORSES ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS AFTER DUSK UNLESS THEY ARE STABLED
- NO MAKESHIFT YARDS, ELECTRIC OR OTHER ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS
- CATTLE YARDS ARE NOT FOR USE BY HORSES
- NO FIRES ALLOWED ON THE GROUND ESPECIALLY AROUND THE STABLE AREAS

Horse Section Rules & Regulations

- The Committee has the right to refuse any entry.
- All Entry fees must accompany entry forms.
- Breeding year dates from 1st August each year.
- At the direction of the Chief Steward, any horse or pony may be requested to be measured. An allowance of 3/8" for shoes will be allowed. EFA measuring accepted.
- All exhibitors compete at own risk.
- The Bendigo Agricultural Show Society is not responsible for any damage or loss of property.
- Novice horse, pony or rider is one (VAS ruling), which has not won a 1st placing, competing singly, in any EFA so mentioned show or gymkhana.
- Local horse or rider is to reside permanently within 30kms of the Bendigo Post Office.
- Breed class entries must be registered with their recognised breed Society.
- The Judge's decision is final. Protests must be lodged with the Chief Stewards of the applicable Horse Section with a \$50 deposit within 30 minutes after the class in dispute.
- Stallions are NOT permitted to compete in Open Saddle classes. Stallions must be shown with bit in mouth.
- Exhibitors cannot compete in both Open and Show Hunter, Hack, Galloway or Pony. Its one or the other only.

STABLES & CAMPING SITES

- STABLES MUST BE PRE BOOKED AND PAID FOR IN FULL ON THE APPROPRIATE ENTRY FORM AND ONLY ALLOCATED THURSDAY NIGHT TO EXHIBITORS THAT ARE MEMBERS OR PATRONS
- AS STABLE NUMBERS ARE LIMITED THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT STABLES WILL BE AVAILABLE IF YOU ARRIVE ON THE DAY
- NO PHONE BOOKINGS OF STABLES WILL BE TAKEN
- AN ALLOCATION OF HORSE STALLS WILL BE POSTED ON THE HORSE SUPERINTENDENTS OFFICE WINDOW
- STABLES FEES – \$16.50 MEMBERS or PATRONS or \$25.00 NON-MEMBERS FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW
- STABLES TO BE EMPTIED BEFORE LEAVING OR A CLEANING FEE WILL BE APPLIED

- ❑ CARAVAN SPACE IS AVAILABLE ON APPLICATION WITH A SITE FEE OF \$25.00 FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW. ANY SITES LARGER THAN A STANDARD CAR, FLOAT OR CARAVAN MUST PARK AS DIRECTED
- ❑ CARAVANS TO BE PLACED ALONG THE WIRE FENCE AT THE REAR OF THE STABLES
- ❑ ANY EXHIBITOR WHO PLACES A HORSE IN AN UNAUTHORISED STALL OR POSITION WILL BE LIABLE TO DISQUALIFICATION BY THE CHIEF STEWARD

ENTRY or EXIT & PARKING

- ENTRY AND EXIT FROM THE SHOWGROUNDS IS THROUGH GATE 3 ONLY (OFF PROUSES ROAD)
 - MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES BETWEEN THE STABLES AREA BETWEEN 8.30AM – 4PM DURING THE SHOW DAYS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

- 1 By signing this waiver I acknowledged that:
 - 1.1 Participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity & may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - 1.2 Participation in horse sports requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
 - 1.3 Horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
 - 1.4 If held at an agricultural show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten horses;
 - 1.5 As the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me & to my horse as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;

I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided.

4 I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the horse sports and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from an event with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.
