Entry Fee: Entry into show at \$20 for Ute & Driver and additional passengers or children pay at gate prices

Entry Fee includes Ute to be eligible to compete in any or all categories.

REGULATIONS

1. Judging to take place from 11.30 am until approximately 1pm.
2. Utes will be displayed outside the Secretaries office.
3. All entrants will be automatically entered into the **People's Choice Award**.
4. All category winners will be eligible for the **2011 Ute of the Show Award**.
5. Sashes & Prizes for each category winner.
6. Judges: To be confirmed.
7. People assisting with the organisation and the on the day running of the Ute show are eligible to exhibit.
8. All entries must be registered as utility (**utility must appear on the registration sticker**), in case of "chicks" classes Ute must be registered in the name of the female exhibitor.
9. Judging will be based on a critique (non-point) system. Each exhibit will be inspected, critiqued and then evaluated by the nominated judge. The winner will be the vehicle the judge feels best represents each category, with a strong emphasis on the quality of the preparation and presentation of the vehicle and demonstrate innovation and individuality.
10. Entrants are required to present their vehicle to the judge. Entrants are encouraged to briefly explain any modifications to the judge during their inspection.
11. Exhibitors are warned that should they not be in attendance of their vehicle during the judges inspection the evaluation will be made on a 'face-value' only. Judges will not open doors or bonnets without the vehicles owner or representative present.
12. Judges decision will be final and will not be entered into after the event; however, critiques will be available for collection by vehicle owner after the grand parade.

UTE CATEGORIES

- ❖ **UTE OF THE SHOW** – winner to receive a Trophy. Awarded to the Ute deemed to be the best presented and most innovative Ute in any category.
- ❖ **BEST STREET UTE** – Judge will be looking at performance modifications and the overall appeal of the vehicle. Utes entered in this category **MUST NOT** have a bull bar or grill guard.
- ❖ **BEST B&S UTE** – Judge will be looking at accessories, theme and other innovative modifications made to the vehicle which best assist and celebrate life in Rural Australia.

- ❖ **BEST CLASSIC UTE** – open to any Ute produced before 1990. Restoration work and/or maintenance taken into consideration. Ute entered in this category must be models produced pre-1985.
- ❖ **BEST 4x4 UTE** – open to any Ute with 4WD capabilities. Extent and quality of off roading, modifications and accessories part of judging process.
- ❖ **PEOPLE CHOICE AWARD** – awarded to the Ute with the most public votes.
- ❖ **BEST CHICKS UTE** – awarded to the Ute deemed to be the best presented and most innovative Ute in any category, vehicle must be registered in the name of a female.
