**Recipe:**

375g (12oz) Sunbeam Mixed Fruit  
3/4 cup Brown Sugar      2 Eggs - lightly beaten  
1 teaspoon Mixed Spice      2 tablespoons Marmalade  
1/2 cup Water      1 cup SR flour  
125g (4oz) Butter      1 cup Plain Flour  
1/2 teaspoon Bi-carb Soda      1/4 teaspoon Salt  
1/2 cup Sherry

**Method:** Place the Sunbeam Mixed Fruit, Sugar, Spice, Water and Butter in a large saucepan and bring to the boil.  
Simmer gently for 3 minutes, then remove from stove, add Bi-carb Soda and allow to cool. Add the Sherry, Eggs and Marmalade, mixing well. Fold in the sifted dry ingredients then place in a greased and lined 20cm round cake tin. Bake in a moderately slow oven for approximately 1 hour or until cooked when tested.

125 grams Soft Butter	125 grams Sugar
½ packet Jelly Crystals (raspberry flavour)	2 Eggs
1 ¾ cups SR Flour	1/3 cup Milk

**Method:** Combine all ingredients then beat well for 3 minutes on medium speed. Prepare loaf tin by greasing sides & lining base with baking paper. Bake in moderate oven for 35 – 40 minutes or until cooked when tested with skewer. Ice when cold and decorate with daisies made from jelly beans.
