5. Sheep Entered in lamb classes must have all milk teeth in place. Lambs are not eligible for Championships.
6. The onus is on the exhibitor to ensure sheep are entered in the correct class.
7. Judging will commence at **10am on Saturday, 23rd October.**

Whilst no responsibility can be taken by the Society for the actions of exhibitors in exhibiting livestock from properties without a declared health status, the Bendigo Agricultural Show Society will adopt a care strategy for all future showing of livestock. This is in line with the strategies recommended by the Department of Natural Resources and Environment and the Victorian Agricultural Societies Association.

Sheep and goat exhibitors will be allocated penning, separated from other breeders and exhibitors by a laneway. Sheds will be cleaned out prior to the show and clean straw provided for each new intake of livestock. It will be the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure that the laneways are kept clear of urine soaked material and faeces and the Society will undertake the responsibility to ensure that judging areas are kept clean and tidy.

### CONDITION OF ENTRY

The General Regulations of the Bendigo Agricultural Show Society Inc. appearing in this schedule form part of these AAA approved conditions of entry. In the event of any inconsistency between the General Regulations and these conditions, the General Regulations shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency unless the General Regulations provide otherwise. This Show will be conducted under the Rules of the Australian Alpaca Association as set out in the current AAA Showing Rules Manual.

Entries close and must be received by the Bendigo Agricultural Show Society by **5pm** on the **23rd September 2011** whether entries are delivered in person or by post. A copy of each exhibits registration certificate must be included when entries are lodged, (both sides) and a Johnes Disease declaration.

### PERIOD OF EXHIBITION

Alpacas must be penned by **8.00am Saturday, 22nd October** in readiness for judging at **9.30am** and may not be removed from the Showgrounds until **close of Show**.

### PREPARATION OF EXHIBITS AND CLEANLINESS OF STALLS

Exhibitors must keep the stalls allocated to their animals clean, and give proper attention to their stock throughout the show. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and feed and water containers.

### ADVERTISING

A4 folders attached to the front of the animal pen is permitted for promotional and sales material otherwise no advertisements or notices (except with the permission of the Chief Steward) are permitted on or in any stalls or buildings. Sale signs are not permitted. Stud names are permitted, but must be contained to the bounds of the pen and to a height of 1500mm. Display or promotional alpacas will not be permitted. Display of Show ribbons awarded at a Show held at another venue is prohibited.

### EXHIBITORS MEETING

There will be no exhibitors meeting unless deemed necessary by the Chief Steward. Any program changes will be announced regularly via the PA system.

### CAR PARKING

**All exhibitors must unload their exhibits in the Pavilion and then park their vehicles in the designated exhibitor car park as quickly as possible. All vehicles must remain in that area until 4pm Saturday.**

### INSPECTION OF EXHIBITS

1. All alpacas must be registered with the Australian Alpaca Association Inc. and carry an approved brass tag showing the alpaca's IAR number. Wethers must be registered alpacas, and owned by a AAA Member. No wether may have any visible genetic faults.
2. No animal shall be eligible for exhibition if it is not entire (except for wethers). All genitalia shall be complete, properly formed and proportioned for normal reproduction.
3. **Inspection of Alpacas will commence at 8am on Saturday 22nd October 2011.**

- The convener of a Show conducted under Association Rules shall appoint a person, or persons, as an inspector, or inspectors, who shall inspect all alpacas for genetic faults, colour class and IAR number.
- The Inspector or Chief Steward will classify all entries for colour and has the power to transfer an exhibit to the class which, in his or her opinion, it should have entered. The Chief Steward will combine or split classes as he or she sees fit.
- Alpacas not in their allocated pens and available for inspection at the official time may be disqualified by the Chief Steward.
- Exhibitors must be in attendance at the time of inspection.
- All huacaya alpacas must carry a minimum fleece length of 50mm and a maximum length not exceeding 140mm**, measured at the mid side. The minimum fleece length for Suri's is 75mm and fleece length will be assessed by the Judge. Exhibits shall not have fleece of a different colour to that of the blanket removed from an animal to a level below that of the blanket fleece.
- Any alpaca found to have lice infestation must be removed from the Showgrounds immediately along with any other alpacas present that belong to the same exhibitor.
- The only person or stud eligible to exhibit an animal is the owner listed in the AAA register or the agent of the registered owner.

NOTE: If there is no IAR tag present in the ear of an animal exhibit, official Association confirmation must be provided by the owner to the Chief Steward that the ear tag has been recently lost and that a new tag has been ordered.

#### JUDGING

- Judging will commence promptly at **9.30am Saturday, 22nd October**.
- A competitor may not discuss with the Judge their alpacas, or proposed exhibits prior to, or during the show judging.
- The Judge's decision shall be final. He or she may choose not to award a prize or prizes in a class.
- All attendants leading stock in the judging ring shall wear a white coat, black pants or skirts with clean dress shoes or boots.
- All Exhibitors to provide their own white coats.
- The Chief Steward may disqualify an exhibitor for incorrect attire.
- All exhibitors shall, on the day of the show, obtain their pen positions and class numbers from the Shed Steward. Class number of the exhibit and the age of the alpaca, in months, must be worn and clearly displayed by the handler whilst in the show ring.
- All handlers showing animals must be competent in the handling of their exhibit, or the Judge may request removal from the ring.
- All exhibitors must place their animals in the pens allotted by the show stewards and must not be moved or removed except by order of the Chief Steward.

#### FLEECES

- All Fleeces being exhibited (including wether fleeces) must be the bona fide property of the AAA Ltd financial Member.
- All Fleece exhibitors must attach the exhibit number (no names) supplied for that class.
- Only one fleece that has been shorn in the 18 months prior to the Show may be shown from any one animal.
- A copy of each exhibits registration certificate must be included when entries are lodged, (both sides).**

#### AGE OF ALPACA

Alpacas must be entered into their correct class for their age (i.e. age on the day of the show unless otherwise specified).

#### PROTESTS

All protests are to be referred to the Chief Steward or Show Convener in accordance with the AAA Ltd. Show Guidelines. Only an exhibitor may lodge a protest.

#### SIRES PROGENY CLASS

- The progeny class is for two progeny of one sire.
- A Sires Progeny entry cannot contain a wether, but may be a group of males, females or males and females. None of the progeny may be younger than 6 months. Progeny need not be owned or bred by the one exhibitor, but all must be the progeny of the one sire and drawn from ordinary classes. Name and details of sire only to be stated on the entry form.

Only one entry fee per group is required. Cost per group \$11.00  
The exhibit may be entered on the day of the show before 12pm.
